Vocal parts: John Barnard: *The First Book of Selected Church Music* (Griffin: London, 1641).

Organ: Oxford, Bodleian: MS Tenbury 791 ("Batten" organ book).

The music has been transposed up a tone and presented in original note values. The Organ book misses out some sections of the music (without comment), and in other places has completely different music. The vocal parts in Barnard are also incomplete, with no surviving vocal parts for some sections, and some assumed missing verses. Some sections of the organ part are therefore completely reconstructed (marked between arrows showing the start and end of a reconstructed section).

The notes below use original pitches to describe notes.

Te Deum

57, Tenor: Originally Contratenor 1.

79, Contratenor 1: Contratenor parts have been swapped from last beat of 79 to b.82.

89, Contratenor 2: Contratenor parts swapped from beat 2 to end of b. 93.

122, Medius: Barnard has a C#, giving consecutive fifths with the Contratenor.

124, Tenor: Barnard partbooks have semibreve E, D, doubling the bass for the last note. The Batten organ book has a 6-5 cadence, and this has been supplied to the Tenor.

134, Bass: Editorially added Bass Verse until the Full section.

135, Tenor: Sources have G# here (both times) against the Can Medius G natural.

141, Medius: This third Medius part could be divided between one of the other Medius soloists and a Contratenor.

148, Medius: Partbooks have *pre-ci-ous*, with the long note subdivided 3+1; but not at 152, where it is two syllables. The word has been given two syllables throughout.

156, Contratenor 1: Organ book has B natural.

159, Tenor: Organ book has B natural, C sharp.

171: The sources have "Verse Can" for the Medius and Contratenor phrase 171-172.

172, Contratenor 2: The music from 172 to 176 is found in the Contratenor 1 book; but as it is given to Cantoris, it has been switched with the music of Contratenor 2.

193, Barnard's partbooks are missing the section "Vouchsafe us...", from bar 193 to 198.

200, Organ: The Batten organ book only has the four-crotchet figure in the first bar (199). From 199 onwards, there are just semibreves. Ouseley repeats the figure in each bar, and this has been copied as a likely ornament.

213, Contratenor 1: Contratenor parts have been swapped from here to b. 222.

230, Contratenor 1: Contratenor parts are swapped from here to the end.

Jubilate

34, Medius: Two of the four Contratenor books and the Bassus book have a semibreve; all others have a minim. The Medius Decani book has the verse notes immediately after the minim. The minim rest has been added editorially. The Medius Cantoris part (in canon) and the organ are editorial for this section.

36, Medius: Editorially supplied Medius Cantoris Verse, until b. 66.

51, Contratenor 1: The Contratenor source has three minim rests between 'pasture' and 'O go your way'.

53: Medius Cantoris verse is editorially supplied.

80, Contratenor 1: Source has D.

81-82: In a reversal of fortune, this Tenor verse has been moved to the Contratenor.

101: The Contratenor Verse from here to the end of 103 is editorial.
